# Inappropriate Content/Information

## Inappropriate Content vs Inappropriate Information

# Inappropriate Content

- Violence
- Hate Speech
- Risky or illegal behaviors

*This type of content is not appropriate or professional for the classroom setting.*

# Inappropriate Information

## Information that you shouldn't share online includes:

- Revealing pictures
- Pranks
- Illegal behavior
- Hate Speech

## Possible Consequences for posting these things online:

- Could hurt your reputation or impact your future college and career plans.
- Could get in trouble at home, at school or even by the law.
- Could lead to loss of privileges and/or disciplinary action.

# What to Do

- Report it to an adult immediately
- Take Screenshot, if instructed

# Best Practices

- Don't share usernames and passwords
- Don't share personal information
- Use privacy settings and check them often
- Choose appropriate screennames
- Only accept friend request from and communicate with people you know in real life
- Don't make jokes that are threats



# Respect Online: Cyberbullying

## What is it?

- Using the internet or electronic means to make another person feel angry, sad, or scared.
- It is something that is done repeatedly.

**TUSD can intervene** with a situation on social media (private accounts) if it affects the victim's ability to feel safe in the educational environment.

# Respect Online: Cyberbullying

## If you see it happening:

- Show support
- Refuse to join in
- Report it to an adult



## If you don't like someone:

- Ignore them when you can
- Be professional and courteous

# Behaving Respectfully When Online

**Your online behavior and actions have enormous consequences.**

## **Possible Consequences for Behaving Disrespectfully:**

- Cause others to feel hurt.
- Impact future professional opportunities.
- Could impact your child's future opportunities.
- Legal consequences.

**Lead by example!**

# Student Use of Device at Home

- Student needs to use the device in a central location in the home and plugged in to charge nightly.

- Monitor student use of the device.
- TUSD has placed filters (E-rate compliant) on the devices to help protect students.
- Student **WILL NOT** have the ability to download apps. Approved TUSD apps will be installed automatically.

- Report damage immediately

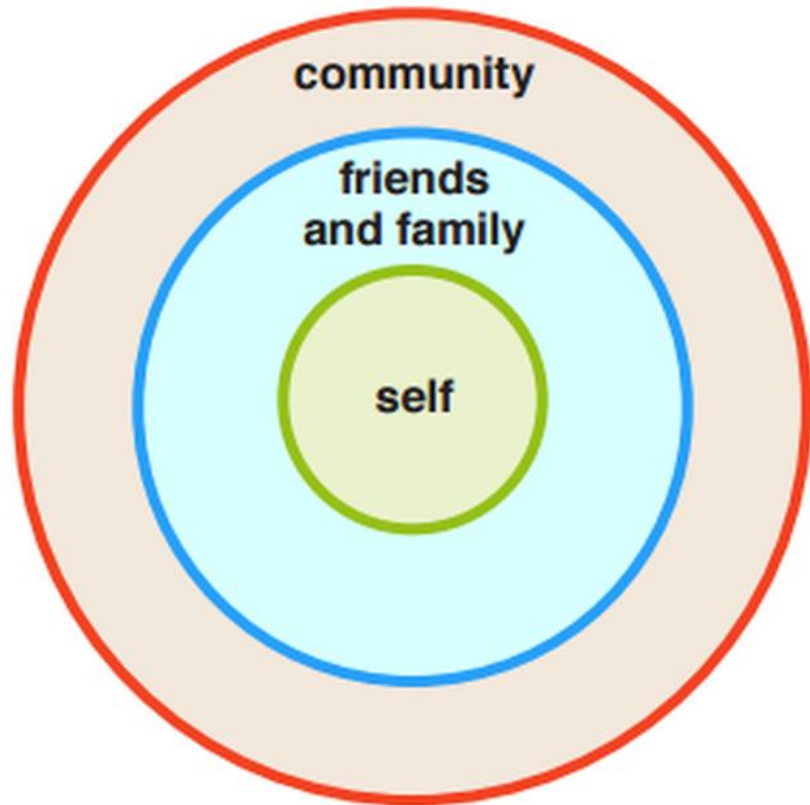
